## SCHOOL PROFILE 2009 - 2010

### ASB MISSION

We inspire all of our students to continuous inquiry, empowering them with the skills, courage, optimism, and integrity to pursue their dreams and enhance the lives of others.

### SCHOOL COMMUNITY

The American School of Bombay (ASB) was founded in 1981 as an independent, coeducational day school in the American Consulate. The school serves Bombay's growing international community and offers an educational program from pre-K through grade 12 for students from over 40 nationalities. The student population of 670 is comprised of 28% U.S. nationals, 13% host country nationals, and 59% third country nationals. There are 65 full time secondary faculty and administrators with the following academic qualifications: Ph.D.: 7, M.A.: 45, B.A./B.S.: 13.

### ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

The American School of Bombay follows a college preparatory curriculum that culminates with an American high school diploma. The school also offers the IB Diploma Program in grades 11 and 12, a rigorous pre-university course of study consisting of six academic courses, a Theory of Knowledge course, an independently researched 4000 word Extended Essay and a balanced two-year engagement with experiential learning through self-selected creative, active and service opportunities (CAS). The required breadth of academic courses includes English literature, a modern language or non-English literature course, a social science, a laboratory science, mathematics and either a creative arts course or a second course from the above.

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Successful completion of a minimum of 23 credits in grades 9 through 12 as follows:

4 English	3 Mathematics	3 Social Studies
3 Science	2 Modern Language	2 Physical Education/Health
1 Technology	1 Fine Arts	4 Electives

In addition, all students must complete the IB CAS (Creativity, Action, Service) requirement to receive an ASB High School Diploma.

### TECHNOLOGY

ASB is proud to be a leader in the use of information technology to enhance students' educational experiences. All students in grades 6 through 12 own a Tablet PC. We believe that by using technology appropriately, students are more highly engaged in their own education, have increased opportunities to develop higher-order thinking skills, and are better prepared to participate in a world where technological fluency is essential.

### CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The following co-curricular activities are offered at ASB: National Honor Society, Student Government, Model United Nations, Yearbook, Drama, AMIS choir and band and ISTA. The school also participates in South Asian Inter-School Association (SAISA) athletic, academic and arts competitions with other international schools in the region. Sports offered include soccer, basketball, volleyball, track & field, swimming, tennis, and badminton. Other events include fine arts festivals, academic games and math. Our Week Without Walls Programs are week-long trips designed to provide students with cross-cultural, service, and physically challenging experiences.

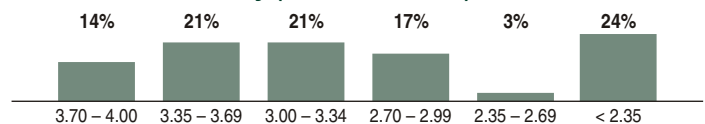
### GRADING SYSTEM

- 7 Excellent performance
- 6 Very Good performance
- 5 Good performance
- 4 Satisfactory performance
- 3 Mediocre performance
- 2 Poor performance
- 1 Very poor performance

\* Marks between 4 and 5 are the most commonly awarded for all subjects worldwide.
